### **Leon County Tax Collector Plans to Open a New Full-service Customer Service Center on South Monroe Street Near FAMU in Late August of This Year**

Leon County Tax Collector Doris Maloy is pleased to announce to the student body of FAMU the opening of a new office at 3485 South Monroe Street (just south of Tram Road) where residents can process Driver Licensing, Motor Vehicle and Vessel Registration and Titling services, Hunting & Fishing licensing in addition to being able to pay all locally levied and collected taxes.

Mrs. Maloy said, "The Southside of Tallahassee is a historically under-served area in terms of a convenient, full service Tax Collector office. Until now, the closest place that folks who live south of downtown had to go to obtain the full range of these services was in the Cross Creek shopping center at the intersection of Capital Circle and Appalachee Parkway."

While customers can handle transactions other than Driver Licensing at either the Courthouse Annex (315 South Calhoun Street) or at the Westside office at 870 Blountstown Highway, neither of those locations is that convenient for most residents of the Southside community.

Other than the Cross Creek location, the only other Tax Collector Service Center that currently processes both Driver License renewals as well as license plate registration renewals is located in the Carriage Gate shopping center at 3425 Thomasville Road.

Mrs. Maloy concluded by saying, "I'm very pleased and proud to finally be able to open a new, state-of-the-art customer service center that will make our services readily available to the last remaining part of our community that lacked convenient access to them."
