The Tax Collector's Lake Jackson Customer Service Center (Located at 3840 North Monroe Street) Will Be Closed to the Public Until September 2, 2014 For Repair of Flooding Damages Caused by a Fresh Water Supply Leak

The Leon County Tax Collector's Lake Jackson customer service location at North Monroe Street and Fred George Road is closed due to flooding caused by a leak in the water supply system that resulted in some flooding damage. The water supply line has been repaired while a private water damage control contractor takes the steps necessary to restore the property.

This office will re-open to the public at 8:30 AM on Tuesday, September 2, 2014.
