**Leon County Tax Collector's Office Relocates From the Main  
Courthouse to the Annex (Formerly the Bank of America Building) on  
Calhoun Street**

On Monday, December 5, 2005, the Leon County Tax Collector's Office in the Courthouse at 301 South Monroe Street will be **closed to the public**. Anyone who needs to do business with the Tax Collector on that date is encouraged to go to one of the following Customer Service Centers:

- Cross Creek (1210 Capital Circle South East)
- Heritage Plaza (2810 Sharer Road)
- Westside (870 Blountstown Highway)
- Woodville (9019 Woodville Highway)

At the request of the Board of Commissioners, the Tax Collector is relocating from the first floor of the Courthouse to the second floor of the former Bank of America Building - now the new Courthouse Annex - which is directly east of the Courthouse at 315 South Calhoun Street. The Board of County Commissioners recently purchased this multi-story office building to house many of the county's functions that are not directly related to the Courts.

"The needs of the Courts and other Court-related functions of County Governments, as well as those of the Board of Commissioners, can best be served within the Courthouse itself. The functions of this Office, as well as those of some of many other County offices, can be performed equally well - if not even better - while located across the street in the Annex where the security screening requirements and other limitations are less stringent" said Mrs. Maloy.

In addition to an office for the Tax Collector herself, the Annex location will include space for Tax administration staff, Legal Counsel, and Computer Technology staff.

The Tax Collector will re-open for business in the County Annex at 8:25 AM on Tuesday, December 6, 2005.
