Instructions for completion are on back of this document

Sections 322.051 and 322.08, Florida Statutes, require that applicants provide proof of residential address documents to obtain a Florida driver license or identification card. Two documents from the approved documents list on the back of this document are required. If the applicant cannot provide two approved residential address documents, this affidavit may be used along with the documents provided by the individual whose name is on the proof of residential address documents or representative from an organization that offers housing services (such as a homeless shelter).

Instructions

The applicant may use this affidavit along with the two proof of residential address documents from another individual or representative from an organization that offers housing services (such as homeless shelter) to meet the residential address requirements in Florida.

The Certification of Address document must be complete, legible, and signed by the applicant and the individual or representative.
Customers who are related to the person they live with must provide two acceptable residential address documents in the relative's name, document(s) demonstrating family relationship, or a signed Certification of Address document.

Acceptable documents demonstrating family relationship may include, but are not limited to:

• Marriage license

• Birth certificate

Military dependent identification card

• Adoption records

If the customer is not able to provide documents to establish the relationship with the relative, a completed Certification of Address, document must be submitted.

The individual the customer lives with who is signing the certification may appear in person and sign the document in the presence of credentialing personnel or they may sign the document in the presence of a notary.

3. Customers that live with a person that is not a family member must provide two acceptable residential address documents in the name of the person they live with and a signed Certification of Address document.

The individual the customer lives with who is signing the document may appear in person and sign the document in the presence of credentialing personnel or they may sign the document in the presence of a notary.

4. A homeless customer may present a homeless certification from a homeless Shelter or public assistance agency, local school district homeless education liaison, or foster parent along with a Certification of Address document.

Acceptable Residency Documents:

- 1. Deed, mortgage, monthly mortgage statement, mortgage payment booklet or residential rental/lease agreement.
- 2. Florida Voter Registration Card.
- 3. Florida Vehicle Registration or Title.
- 4. Florida Boat Registration or Title.
- 5. Statements (Certification of Address)
- 6. A utility hook up or work order.
- 7. Automobile Payment Booklet.
- 8. Selective Service card.
- 9. Medical or health card.
- 10. Medical bill.
- 11. Homeowner's insurance policy or bill.
- 12. Automobile insurance policy or bill.
- 13. Educational institution transcript forms.
- 14. Professional license issued by a government agency in the U.S.
- 15. W-2 form or 1099 form.
- 16. Form DS2019, Certificate of Eligibility for Exchange Visitor (J-1) status.
- 17. A letter from a homeless shelter, transitional service provider, or half-way house verifying that the customer resides at the shelter address.
- 18. Utility bills.
- 19. Mail from financial institutions; including checking, savings, credit card statements or investment account statements.
- 20. Mail from Federal, State, County or City government agencies (including city and county agencies).
- 21. Personal mail that does not list the recipient as "occupant".

Example: Magazines, journals, etc.

- 22. Homeless Sexual Offender/Predator/Career Offender:
 - FDLE Registration form completed by the local sheriff's department.
- 23. Certification of Address.
